



We also want to thank Carole Crothers who came over on very short notice to act as standby judge. She worked with Bill Hutchins on most tracks and rejudged two teams that were given a second chance. Carole has agreed to serve as judge in 1984.

We had a camera-person present. Charlotte Schwartz video-taned several of the tracks, including the one successful team. The only disappointment was that we only had one team pass for certification. Several other dogs tracked very well only to miss the final turn or fail to indicate the article. Three were given a second chance but seemed tired and unable to handle two tests in one day.

Future plans include a covered dish meeting on January 15, Awards banquet on March 26, and Tracking Experience Day on April 9, so mark vour calendars now. We are continuing to assemble the information wanted by AKC for recognition as a club eligible to run tracking tests. A TRAINING HINT:

At the Certification match, it became evident that several of the dogs were tracking well but did not pick-up or indicate the article at the end of the track. A couple of handlers told me they had force trained their dogs to retrieve a dumbbell and since they didn't want to use this negative approach on the track, they had been unable to get the dog to pick-up the glove. Since the dog fails if he doesn't indicate and/or pick-up the article, no matter how accurately he followed the track, it seemed to me there had to be a solution.

After confirming my idea with our mentor, Charlotte Schwartz, I suggest the following: retrain the retrieve, using "The Inducive Retrieve Method" as printed in the August 1976 OFF-LEAD. While the article is written by a Sue Rose of Michigan, it describes a training technique learned from Glen Johnson (a familiar name!). If you follow each step exactly as described and if your dog is hungry enough, you will have a retriever who is reliable and happy. I speak from experience. I have trained three Dobermans, one Norwich Terrier and one Schipperke using the method and it works. Don't try it for a few days and quite. It takes time and patience, but it is worth it. You may have to cut back on Fido's meals for several days to make the dog hungry enough. My Schipperke had one quarter of normal rations for three days when she suddenly realized that she could make up for lack of dinner by bringing back that dumbell everytime it appeared. My only probelem now is she anticipates and tears out for the thing before being told to get it -- but we'll solve that in time.

If our editors feel we won't be sued, I'll ask them to include the two pages of instructions in this issue. Otherwise, write to me and I will send you a copy. But if you try it, remember, don't skip steps, don't lose your cool and be quick with the reward. Timing is all important. Good Luck!

The weekend of November 13 - 14 gave us some cold, blustery weather and some events that really showed us for the cohesive, experienced and energetic club that we are:

To briefly recap, our judge, Bill Hutchins, developed trouble with his high blood pressure which peaked during the laying of the 4th track on Saturday. He received prompt medical attention from the Lebanon Township First Aid Squad and, after taking his medicine and eating a hearty lunch, returned to the fields. With the capable help of our tracklayers, he finished plotting tracks for Sunday's match -- which he ably judged.

We had about a dozen club members available on Saturday for tracklaying assignments, general assistance, etc. Sunday brought out some more new members and numerous spectators to watch our seven entrants try for the elusive TD certification.

Edith Braginton's Weimaraner bitch, Djinn, was the only dog to find the glove. Several dogs did fine until the last turn or leg and then just didn't seem to have the motivation or experience to continue to the end. A shame. The most disappointing performance to this spectator was one dog who passed over the glove with no indication to his handler. Insult to injury: He did this two times as he also ran a spare track. Oh heartbreak!!

Cther breeds entered were German Shepherd (2), Shetland Sheepdog, German Shorthaired Pointer, English Cocker Spaniel, and another Weimaraner, King. King was notable in that he had no formal tracking training (tho' lots of field work) and his handler had never even read Johnson's book -- only been to one TD seminar in 1975!. You better believe the gallery started to get real nervous when King completed his 2nd turn! He finally blew the 3rd leg but not before he taught us domething about "natural instincts" and "guts" (on the part of his handler).

In sum, it was an exciting weekend for dog and human alike.

I only wish the rest of the dogs could have been certified, too.

If clubs were judged, i'd say WE PASSED!
