Lacey earned her Started Sheep Herding title*(STDs) in one herding weekend with third place on Sat , Highest Scoring STDs Aussie on Sun and High Combined STDs for the weekend

A mere ninety minutes after leaving the herding arena on Sat AND Sun Lacey qualified decently in novice obedience finishing her CD.

Lacey ended up with Reserve Most Versatile Award for the weekend.

Actually it is STDs -started sheep herding title

Lisa explains that a STD's title is made up of two courses A & B. One is clockwise around a 300x200 arena and the other is counterclockwise. "A" is counterclockwise the dog must "nicely" take sheep out of small pen hold them until owner shuts gate and move sheep around arena thru two panels one on each side of arena and then back to pen, hold sheep off pen and then repen. "B" is clockwise, however instead of taking sheep out of pen dog must gather sheep and start course thru same panels and again repen.

These are ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America) courses. ASCA wants to see the dog's style manipulating the sheep where it seems AKC is more course oriented. At this level, the handler may take any position in the arena. Murphy and Shelby have their HT's (Herding Titles) which is AKC equivalent of a level or two below this ASCA course.

Janet Horn's Chesapeake bitch, CH Eastern Waters Keep The Faith went Best of Breed at Virginia K.C. on April 9 in Richmond, VA. Faith also went Best Opposite a Twin Brooks K.C. onMarch 26 in Morristown, NJ. Faith won Best Opposite at Monmouth County KC onMay 27. Faiith was breeder-owner handled by Janet—who was proud and happy at the accomplishments.

Directions to the 25th Anniversary Picnic


Memorial Park, Lebanon Township, Glen Gardner, New Jersey

DIRECTIONS:

From the East: I-78 to Exit 16 (Route 31 North). * Take Rt. 31 north - as you approach the second light, stay to the right as jug handle takes you off onto Route 513 at the 513 - Grayrock Shopping Center - at the STOP sign turn right and note mileage at this point. Follow Rt. 513 to and through High Bridge. (513 makes several turns in the town of High Bridge - just follow the Route 513 signs). Shortly past Voorhees High School, turn left onto Rt. 628. There is an old, unopen Sunoco gas station on the corner. This turn will be 3.9 miles from the light on Rt. 31. Follow Rt. 628 up hill. As the road starts to level off look for the Memorial Park sign on the left opposite the first driveway to Woodglen School.

Pull straight into the park. We will be using the pavilion area.

From the West: I-78 to Exit 15. Right at end of ramp. Take Main Street into the town of Clinton. At the light in the center of town, turn left onto Halstead Street (Route 513). Observe the speed limit here! Halstead will end at Route 31 where




