Recent Lenape Events: Tracking Certification Day, Aug 25th 2018

On one of the nicest morning we have had all summer, four Lenape board members met with five potential tracklayers. Ben Hoyle, Janet Kelly, Gina DeAlmedia joined me at the Mountain Farm park in Lebanon Township where we have held tests in the past. We were able to gather behind the brown house and sit on the patio in the shade.

Mollie Sumner and Renee Gyuro (TED class of 2018) have already completed the requirements for membership. Joyce Smuda and Denise Marquist (TED Class of 2017) had us sign their membership applications at the end of the day.

Monique Buzzarté, who has been working on tracking with Gina, needs to attend a second event to finalize her application.

We discussed basics and Ben set up a measured pace. They worked in pairs to lay a track with all the flags in place. Then they "laid" the track leaving dark blue poker chips at the turns and at the end.

Next on the day was true/false test on the tracking rules. It was an open book test. After they finished the test we went over all the questions, some were a little tricky.

Then they went out to walk their tracks and find their chips. They were all able to come back with their 5 blue chips.

All of the participants were enthusiastic about what they were learning and feel it will help them in training their dogs. And Lenape has some more certified tracklayers.

The tracklayer certification is done without dogs, but there was one present. He was there to be socialized. Coffee Cup's Travelin' Man, a redheaded tri Pembroke Corgi who came along with Peg Forte, who led the training. By the time the participants were taking the test "Travis" was taking a nap.
