She was born in Amsterdam, New York on April 17, 1936 the daughter of Joseph and Mary Wright Fratianni. Joanne loved raising her family. She also enjoyed breeding and showing her golden retrievers, reading, and cooking. She was a member of the Waterford Congregational Church, a member and past trustee of the Waterford Historical Society, a member of the Golden Retriever Club of America and a foundingmember of the Lenape Tracking Club of Central New Jersey. She is survived by her husband of 66 years, Ralph; her children Susan Black and husband Tod, Nancy Fortuna, Lauren Parillo and husband Joe, Russell MacKinnon and wife Patricia and Robert MacKinnon and wife Jackie; and 10 grandchildren.

REMEMBERING JOANNE MACKINNON- written by Peg Forte

In October 2023, Joanne McKinnon, the co-founder of the Lenape Tracking Club, passed away in Maine.

Joanne and Ralph, moved to Maine in the fall of 2002, so many of our current members never got know them.

In the fall od 1972 Joanne started training her first golden retriever, Reb, in an obedience class held at North Hunterdon high school With 5 children at home, the young active dog needed to learn how to behave. My German Shepherd, Rajah. and I started in the same class. During the summer months a group from the class started meeting in local parks and our home yards.

We also entered match shows. Back then you entered in the morning and would spend the whole day. We would bring our lunch and had lots of time to talk and share training ideas.

Joanne and I had read some info about tracking and thought it looked like fun for the dogs. We took the info we had, some large garden stakes, gloves and started trying tracking. At the matches we shared what we were doing with our friends. Some of them were interested in trying it. Joanne and I desided to get together with those who were interested to see if there was enough interest to form a club. That was in June 1975.

Joanne never earned a TD with Reb (he did earn a UD), nut earned her first TD TD with Piper, a Golden in 1980. She went on to earn 4 more TD's with Goldens she bred. Her story of Chase;s TD is below. Joanne and Chase

It will probably take me longer to write about Chase's TD than it took him to run his track!



Chase is officially BIT O' SKYE'S CHASE A RAINBOW and he has been glove crazy ever since we started playing with the "glovie" which I think was just after he left the whelping box! You see, tracking was natural for Chase considering that his grandpa Skye passed his TD at Lenape's first test in '90, his uncle Chip passed his at the Burlington KC test in '95 and his mom Ruffie passed at Lenape's test in '96.

On the day of the test everything seemed to go just right (well almost everything). We drew Track #1, which was in a beautiful field and Chase was ready to track. We had

a very good start for about 10 feet until he noticed the farm equipment off to the side of the track. He cautiously investigated it and then decided it wasn't going to attack him, so he got back to tracking. Then just past the second flag Nature called so he went off to the side of the track to answer the call.

Now back to tracking and after a slight line entanglement at the first turn, he never stopped until the glove was in his mouth. What a thrill! Even though I have tracked many dogs, I have never had a dog with such confidence and desire on a track as Chase. I feel very fortunate to have this youngster (thirteen months old) as my tracking partner. I know we will have many more tracking experiences in our future.

We have to thank Cheryl Smagala and her Newfie puppy who showed up every Monday morning faithfully to track for keeping us on track! We also have to thank Lenape Tracking Club for providing encouragement for everyone to get out and track.
