

Lenape Worker Draw Program

AKC Rule: Section 17d Test Worker Option. A club may set aside tracks for test workers from previous tests, as defined and identified by the test giving club. This information and the number of tracks to be set aside must be published in the premium list. Entries from workers are to be drawn first, up to the limits shown in the table below. Once the tracks set aside for workers are filled, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks. There will be no separate alternate list for test workers only. A test worker may not benefit from a track set aside at a test in which they are working. Deviations from the table are not permitted for any test.

Tracks	# of Worker Tracks Allowed
1-2	0
3-5	1
6-8	2
9-11	3
12 or more	4

The purpose of this program is to encourage tracking personnel to volunteer at Lenape events by providing a higher chance for test workers to get a draw in a Lenape Tracking test. It should be noted that this provision does not guarantee a test worker a slot in a Lenape test. It only provides an increased chance of getting drawn into the test.

Who qualifies?

- Any person who works a Lenape test/event is eligible for this program:
 - Lenape members or pending members during the time the work is being done.
 - Judges who are judging a Lenape test or other event
 - Non-members who are asked by Lenape to work at an event

What events qualify?

- Lenape tracking tests: (TD, TDU, TDX, VST).
- Other events include: Lenape TED, Lenape Tracking classes, and Lenape Track layer certification.
- All decision will be finalized by the Lenape Board. The Board may include additional events at their discretion; IE: Newsletter, Board Position, Web-site, etc.

What work qualifies?

- Secretaries, Chief Track Layer, Judges, Tracklayers, housing judges, food coordinator, transporting judges to and from airport, obtaining fields for tracking test, and hospitality chairperson will receive 1 draw preference for each day of the test that they work.
- Food providers, drivers, Cross Track Layers will receive 1 draw preference per day worked. Example: A driver that works only Saturday will get 1 a draw preference. If they also work Sunday, they get a second draw preference.

- If the position is not listed above but the Chief Track Layer or Chairperson feels that the position should receive a draw preference, they have the right to issue one.

Certification Process:

- A draw preference certificate will be given to each Lenape worker to be used at their discretion in any Lenape event that offers a worker's draw.
- It will take two draw preferences to get into the worker's draw.
- The certificates will be given out by the Chief Track Layer or Chairperson of the event. It is the responsibility of the worker to be sure he/she receives a certificate.
- A standard certificate will be used by all Chief Track Layers or Chairpersons. The President (or a person designated by the President) will provide the certificate blank. The blank will contain the person's name, the event, the date, and the duty performed.
- The certificates must be sent at the time of entry to the appropriate Event Secretary.
- A certificate is non-transferable to another person. It can only be used on an entry for a dog owned, co-owned, or handled by the person to whom it was issued.
- Certificates can be combined to enter one dog if that dog is co-owned or handled by multiple people.
- Certificates can only be used once.
- If there are not enough entries to require a draw, then the worker gets in the test and there is no worker draw required – the Certificates are returned to the worker.
- If there is a draw and the workers entry does not get drawn into the test, the Certificates will be returned.

Carry over:

- Certificates are good for 24 months from issuance date.

Workers Draw:

If there are more entries for a test than tracks being offered, the draw will be conducted as follows:

- The workers draw will be conducted before the general draw from the non-workers entries.
- The only entries in the initial draw pool (workers draw) are the ones submitted with worker certifications.
- The tracks set aside for the workers draw will be drawn (see table at top).
- After the designated number of set aside tracks are drawn, the remaining workers entries are put into the draw pool with the remaining non-worker entries and the draw for the remaining tracks is completed as normal.
- Worker certifications do not get preference for positions on the alternate list.
