NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

CLOSING DATE for the test is 12 P.M. Thursday, April 2, 2026, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

ENTRIES shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached, and a drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing to determine which entries will participate in the test.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES will be in the presence of the Tracking Test Committee at 7:30 P.M. on Thursday, April 2, 2026 at the home of the Test Secretary, 133 Ealer Hill Road, Kintnersville, PA 18930. The drawing shall be completely at random among all the entries received, except that preference shall be given to those dogs which have not previously earned a variable surface tracking title. The Worker Option draw shall be conducted first. Immediately after the Worker Option draw, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on Alternate Lists corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The Secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw.

WORKER OPTION DRAW AKC Test Worker Option will be used for this test. Test entrants who have worked at previous Lenape events must submit two worker certificates with their entry to be included in the Worker Draw.

TEST SECRETARY ALLOWED TO ENTER In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the Tracking Regulations, the LTC permits the test secretary to enter dogs owned or co-owned by the secretary, and to handle dogs in the tracking test. Should the test secretary enter a test, the drawing for entries will be conducted by another member of the event committee, as will, if applicable, the drawing for tracks.

ENTRY FEES include \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$4.00 event service fee.

MAIL all entries with fees to: Monique Buzzarté, 133 Ealer Hill Road, Kintnersville, PA 18930. Entries not on official AKC entry forms & photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

TELEPHONED, TELEGRAPHED, UNSIGNED, OR ENTRIES WITHOUT FEES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. No entry shall be made and none accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee and will have to be made good with cash or a money order prior to showing. The Test Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded, in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

BITCHES IN SEASON Entrants must notify the Test Secretary and judges that their bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. Bitches in season will participate only after all other dogs have been tested.

REFUNDS. Entry Fees for an Alternate that does not participate in the Tracking Test shall be refunded within 7 days. In the event an accepted Entry withdraws after the closing date to allow an Alternate to replace said Entry, THE ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED. In the event an Accepted Entry withdraws after the closing date and there is no Alternate to replace said Entry, THE ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. IF because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the test, NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE.

EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS The Club reserves the right to cancel the test in the case of extreme weather conditions. Entrants will be contacted on the phone number provided on their entry form.

CANINE PARTNERS Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may participate.

Headquarters: Follow directions on the next page to the college. From Campus Drive, turn onto Alumni Drive and continue past the police station on your right until Alumni Drive dead ends into a parking lot. This is Headquarters.



Restrooms: There is a Little League building with running water behind the HQ parking lot that may be open. If not, here are porta-potties alongside the Little League fields towards the college. There's also a Dunkin' Donuts approximately 5 minutes from Headquarters: turn right onto Newman Springs Road and it will be on the right just past Swimming River Road/50.

Directions to Brookdale Community College

From North or South Jersey, use the Garden State Parkway. If you're driving down from North Jersey, be sure to choose "Local Exits" lanes after the Raritan Bridge, not the "Express" lanes.

Southbound, coming from North Jersey and New York

To avoid the congestion of Exit 109-Red Bank, our standard exit, you can use Exit 114. Keep right - pay the toll -and make a right onto Red Hill Road. Then make a left at the next light onto Crawford Everett Road. (St. Catharine's Church). Follow to the end - and at the T make a left onto Route 520 (Newman Springs Road). Head East on Route 520 past Christian Brothers Academy (on the left) and Thompson Park (on the right). Brookdale will be on your right - look for our red sign at the roundabout.

If you use Exit 109-Red Bank

At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn right onto Route 520 West (Newman Springs Road). Stay west on Route 520 about two miles; just after the town of Lincroft, Brookdale will be on your left - look for our red sign at the roundabout.

Northbound, coming from South Jersey

Use Exit 109-Red Bank and merge to the FAR left at the bottom of the Exit ramp. Make the left onto Route 520 West (Newman Springs Road). Stay west on Route 520 about two miles, through the town of Lincroft; the College entrance will be on the left.

From Western New Jersey

Take Route 33 towards the Halls Mills Road - NORTH exit. This becomes Kozloski Road; follow north to the intersection with Route 537. Turn right and continue east on 537 until it intersects with Route 34. Turn left onto Route 34 North. At the next traffic light, turn right onto Phalanx Road; stay on Phalanx about 3 miles. The entrance to Brookdale will be on the left after crossing the Swimming River Reservoir bridge.

From Route 18 Northbound

Exit at 15A-Wayside Road. Follow to Route 537 to Laird Road to Phalanx Road where you will see the College entrance on the left after the Reservoir.

From Route 18 Southbound

Use the Route 520 East exit and follow to the College.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standalone Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials) should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
